

ITF TRAINS 85 OFFICERS OF PLATEAU STATE LOCAL GOVERNMENT SERVICE COMMISSION

The Industrial Training Fund has commenced the training of Administrative and Personnel Officers of the Plateau State Local Government Service Commission.
